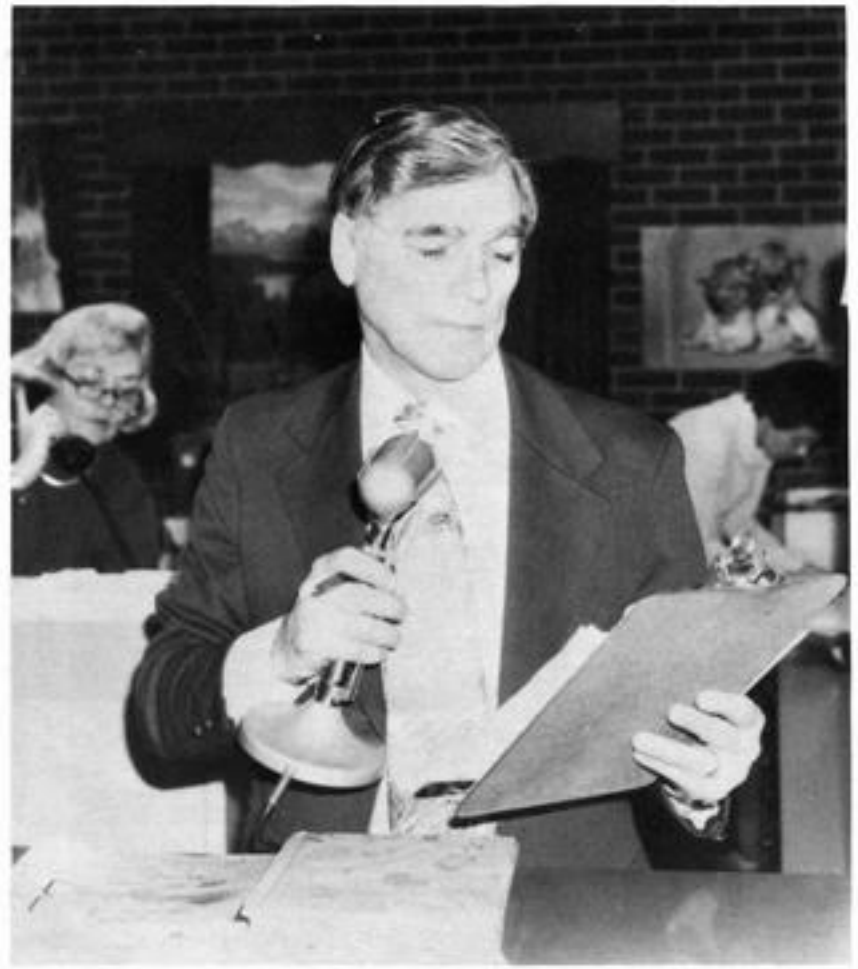

Message from the Principal

POET IN RESIDENCE

For the second consecutive year, the John F. Kennedy Jr. High School has had a Poet-in-Residence Program. This year's poet, who has had several poems published, was Ms. Theresa Cader. 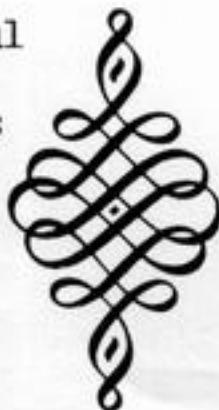

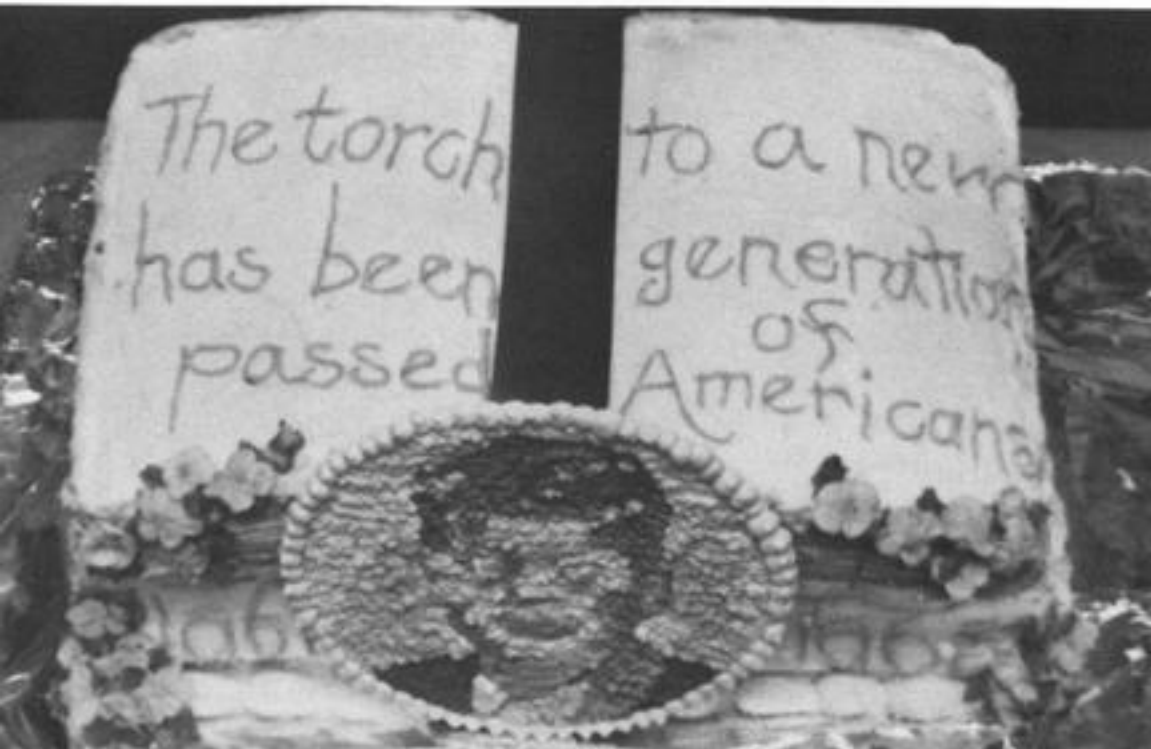

J.F.K. Remembers Abraham

Fifteen years ago, our president was killed. This was one of the first schools named for him. Therefore, we designated one week in November as John F. Kennedy Week. During that memorial time, students studied Kennedy and the time period in which he lived. An essay contest on this subject was held and winners were awarded trophies. As a highlight of Kennedy Week, we were privileged to have a guest speaker, Mr. David Powers, who spoke to us from his knowledge of the late President Kennedy as a close personal friend. At present, Mr. Powers is the curator of the J.F.K Library. This program of events made a real contribution to our school because it enabled us to learn a great deal in a personal way about a leader who might have otherwise remained merely another obscure figure in American history.



Martin And John

In January, we at the John F. Kennedy Jr. High School participated in a week-long program designed to acquaint students with the late Dr. Martin Luther King and his work. Through films and readings, students learned about the man, his times, and his great contribution to our society in the field of civil rights. As a highlight of the week, Senator William Owens was invited to speak to our student body at a commemorative assembly.

Like John F. Kennedy and Martin Luther King, Abraham Lincoln also laid down his life for his fellow man. A special assembly honoring him was held in February. A professional actor excellently portrayed events in Lincoln's life, including the Civil War and the proclamation ending slavery.

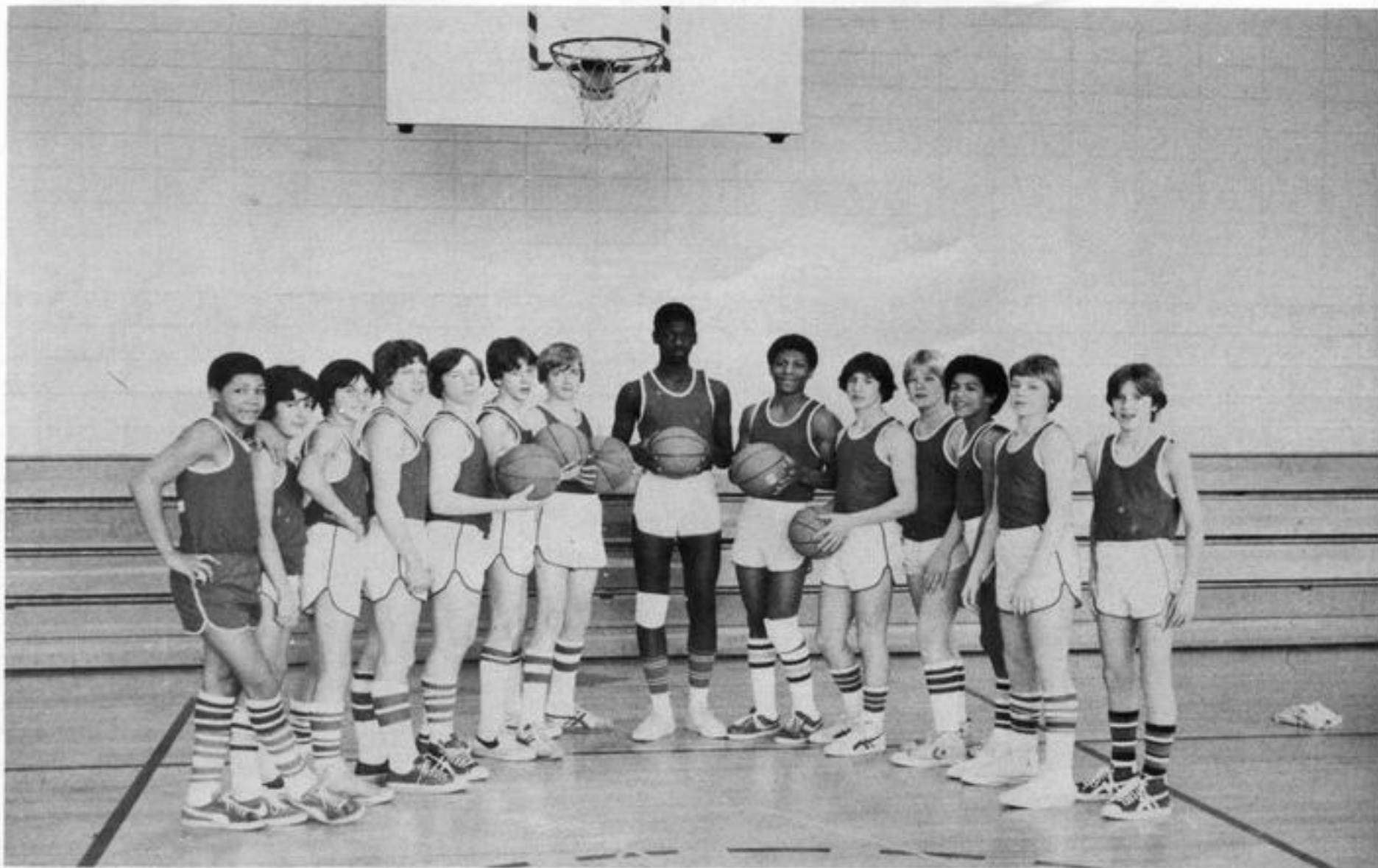

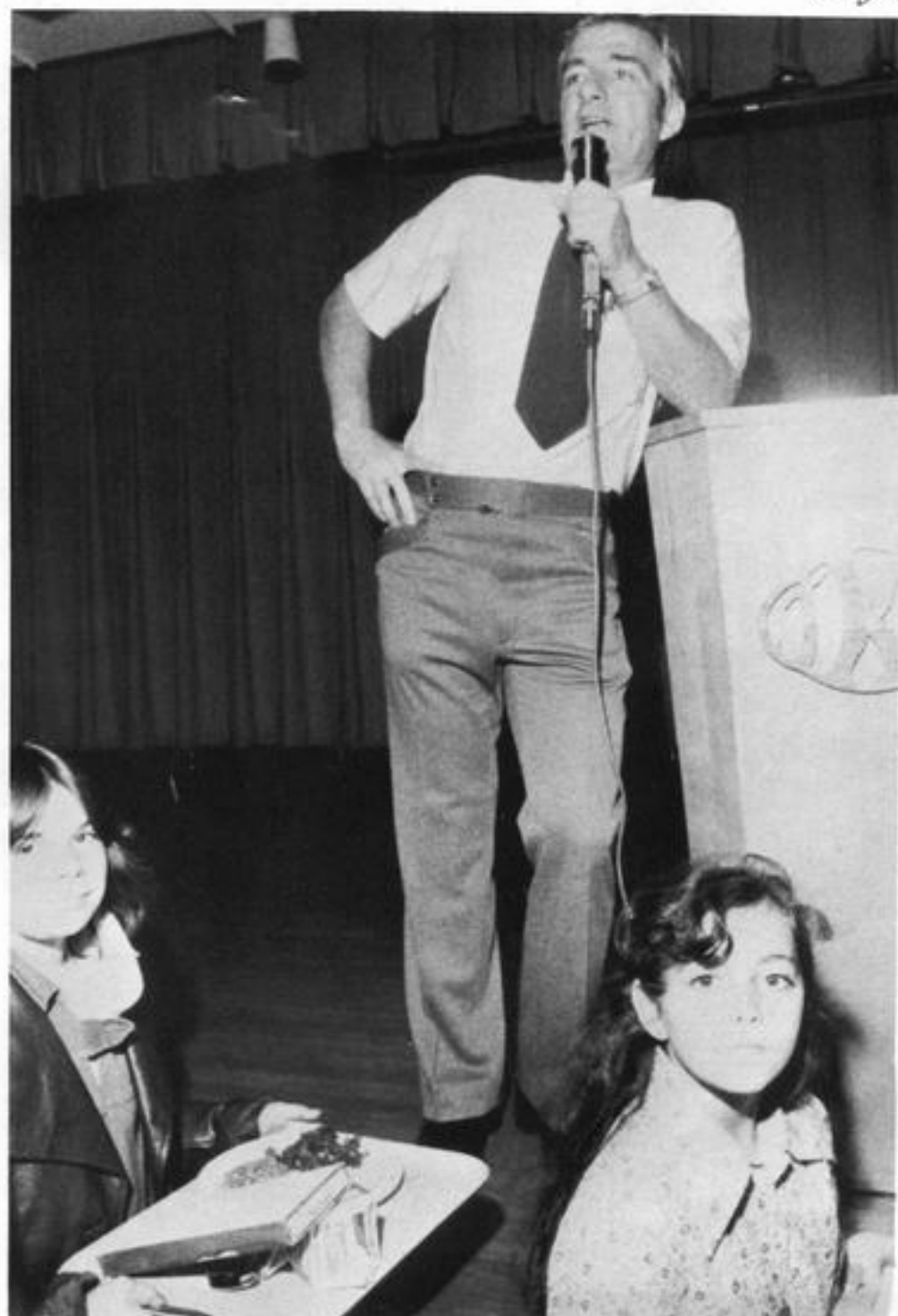

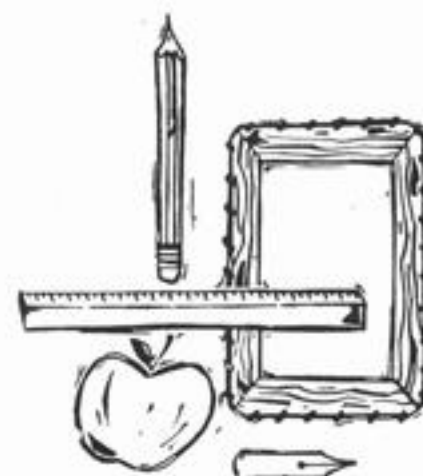
